



Bryan Cook, PhD, is a professor of special education at the Curry School of Education at the University of Virginia. Dr. Cook currently co-directs the Consortium for the Advancement of Special Education Research (CASPER), is past-president of the Council for Exceptional Children's Division for Research, and co-edits the iournal Behavioral Disorders. Last fall, CASPER co-hosted, with the Center for Open Science, a meeting of approximately 40 journal editors and scholars in special education to explore the adoption of open science practices in the field. Dr. Cook has conducted meta-research on replication research and publication bias in his field, and is a leading advocate for the adoption of open science practices in education. In addition to studying the issues related to open science, Dr. Cook has begun to apply open science in his own work.
